Sept. 10, Blessing of the Field

10 am | Civic Center Theater of the Green, Prescott Valley
Against the backdrop of almost 3000 American flags, this Remembrance Ceremony, unique to the Prescott Valley Healing Field of Northern Arizona, honors the memory of the 3000 9/11 victims. The 470 public servants made up of 343 Fire, 72 Law Enforcement and 55 Military that gave their lives that day will be honored with a ceremonial tribute called "Placing of the Boot". A symbolic pair of boots will be placed at the foot of the Flag that represents that service in honor of their sacrifice.

Sept. 10, Patriotic Run

The Patriot Run is a 10k, 5k and 1 mile run fundraiser that benefits the Central Arizona Honor Guard and helps to support the mission to "Honor the Fallen and Honor the Flag."
